COST CATEGORY: \$5,000 TO \$10,000

NAME OF ITEM: Chison 600-Vet Portable Ultrasound (includes the machine, abdominal convex transducer probe 3.5/5/6/7 MHz, a cart, and a black and white Sony thermal printer)

ESTIMATED COST: \$9,221.24

SERVICE: ICU/Critical Care

USE OF EQUIPMENT: Primarily, this device will be used for aiding in quick diagnostic procedures for critical patients in ICU. The ultrasound will eliminate unnecessary movement of the critical patient to the Medical Imaging area. It will also eliminate multiple bladder sticks that are often unnecessary in ICU. The machine will be readily available to guide technicians and clinicians in this necessary and essential diagnostic test.

ESTIMATED ONGOING COST FOR UPKEEP:

Additional costs may include purchasing additional diagnostic probes if wanted or required in the future.
